I am in full support of Dr. Stojkovic questioning vaccine safety and efficacy. I am part of a physicians group, called Physicians for Informed Consent, or PIC. We are hundreds of medical doctors from the US who have issues with the lack of informed consent, the lack of safety studies and the waning efficacy of many vaccinations.

Vaccine safety trials do not include testing against inert placebo and therefore, the safety profile is unknown. Hence, no benefit versus risk ratio can be obtained.

In addition, mandating vaccines in a one size fits all fashion, ignores the fact the some will be severely injured or die from an adverse event.

Dr. Stojkovic is exercising her right as a physician to question a one size fits all prescribing method.

There is a moderate sized minority of patients whose epigenetics make vaccinating a risky endeavor.
