Dear Dr Jovana Stojkovic MD

Thank you for your recent correspondence. I am alarmed by the suggestion that the Serbian Chamber of Medicine is considering revoking your medical license simply because you are reporting on the science underlying vaccine safety.

As you know, we have a research programme on vaccine safety and specifically on the potential dangers of aluminium adjuvants used in many vaccines. While the polarised nature of vaccine safety science often makes it difficult to research in this field the politics do not alter the science and it is an accepted truth by all including vaccine manufacturers that some individuals respond very badly to vaccines. They become ill and the continuum of effects ranges from something simple like a sore arm to something as catastrophic as brain encephalopathy and even death.

It is extremely important that all recipients of vaccines including their guardians and their carers receive full transparency about their safety. It is equally important that anyone receiving a vaccine has freedom of choice in this matter. Many governments around the world are taking this issue very seriously as evidenced by my recent invitation from the Polish Parliament to talk about this issue.

Dr Stojkovic, you are doing your duty as a doctor in informing individuals about vaccine safety science. I am confident that the Serbian Chamber of Medicine will recognise this and rather than look to exclude you from medicine will applaud your stance on behalf of the Serbian people.
